The **Wisconsin Wheelchair Sports Association (WWSA)** is a 501(c)(3) non-profit group working to improve the opportunities for sports activities for wheelchair users. WWSA helps to fund wheelchair activities including Bowling, Fishing, Skiing, Basketball, Softball and Wheelchair Racing. Sports and recreation activities such as these improve the physical well-being of the participants as well as increasing the mental health, self-respect, and social skills of the wheelchair users.

WWSA was founded in 1982 by wheelchair users and is still primarily run by disabled people. It is a testament to the beneficial effects of the wheelchair sports that the group has continued to work these past 28 years to provide meaningful sports activities for the disabled community of Wisconsin.

The WWSA also runs **Wheelplay** in conjunction with the Milwaukee Public School System. Wheelplay is a sports and recreation center for wheelchair users and non-disabled people to play and enjoy wheelchair sports and recreation activities.
